

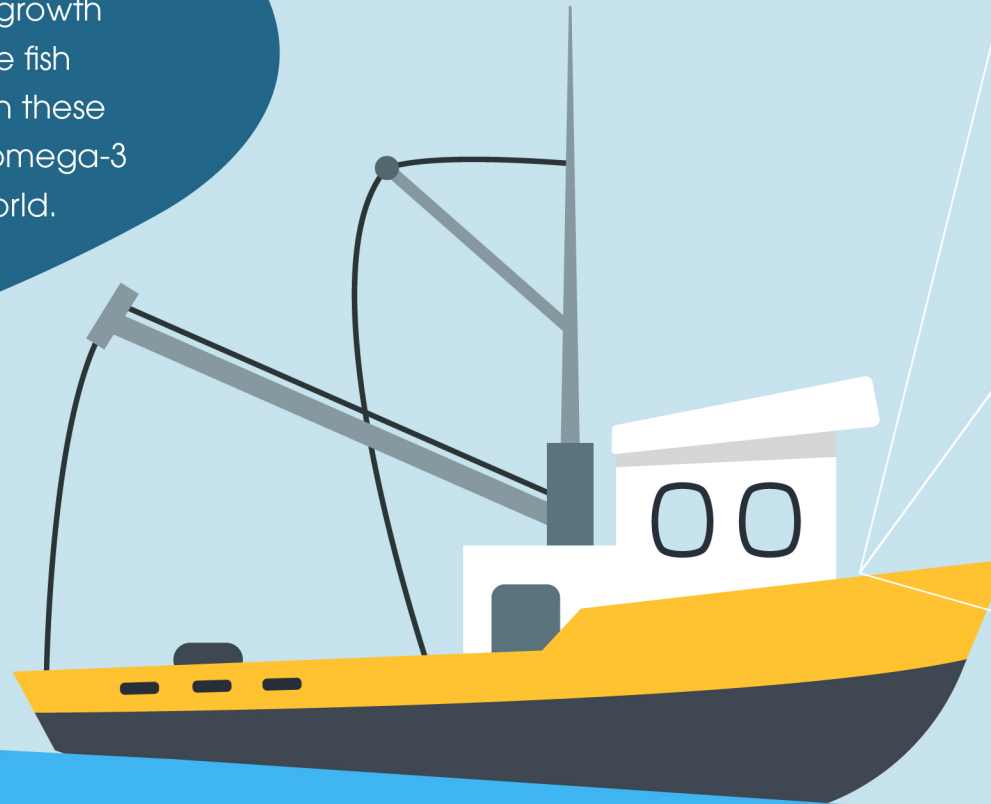

# Fishing in the pure arctic sea

## Factory at sea with no wastage

Our ships use 100% of the fish that they take out of the sea. The main product is fresh fish filets delivered to the European market. All excess of the fish is pressed into crude fish oil on the ship. The dried remains are then turned into pellets, which are used for fish food to fish farmers. MSC certified fishing means that our boats fish in sustainable ways, making sure that the fish stock is kept at good level to make sure that there is no overfishing and that there will be fish in the sea for the future.

The pure arctic waters create the best growth conditions for the fish making the fish in these areas the most omega-3 rich fish in the world.

# Reusing all resources in production

## ECO-Friendly production

When our factory at Pharma Marine gets the raw and fresh fish oil, the boat makes sure that the oil has been kept sealed so that the oil is not exposed to any air, which would contaminate the oil.

## Distillation process

In the distillation process, all excess materials and pollution in the raw oil are separated and the waste is burned as part of the heating to both the distillation tanks and heating in the factory and offices.

## Pure Arctic Oil

From the distillation process, we get the purest of oils. Our Pure Arctic Oil is combined with organic olive oil from Terra Creta and placed in the bottle made of recycled plastic that can be recycled again. All this is done to minimize our impact on the earth.

## Temperature

Cold seawater from the fjord, just outside the factory is used in the distillation process to cool down the oil. In this process, the cold seawater is heated and the heat from this water is also used to regulate the temperature in the factory.
